

Control of animal diseases and certification of vaccination passports (veterinary)

When traveling abroad with pets, many countries require officially certified vaccinations and examinations of the animals. Animal examinations and the corresponding certificates are available from LMTVet.

Basic information

As part of the control of notifiable animal diseases, certain control strategies are prescribed by the Animal Diseases Act and the resulting ordinances. The LMTVet is responsible for ordering and monitoring these necessary measures.

If your vet or you yourself suspect a notifiable animal disease in your animal, the LMTVet is the authority to be notified.

What documents do I need?

- Vaccination certificate (veterinary)

The vaccination certificate for a vaccination carried out on an animal is issued by the treating veterinarian. The Food Inspection, Animal Welfare and Veterinary Service certifies this vaccination on request for travel abroad.
