Basic information

If illegal waste deposits occur, for example on the street, the roadside greenery, in public green spaces and on other municipal properties, they will be removed by the city.

Illegal dumping, as distinguished from street sweeping and bulky waste collection, is defined as follows:

- Amount of waste that exceeds the quantity of a bag in the size of approximately 100 liters,
- environmentally hazardous substances such as refrigerators, oil cans regardless of the quantity.

How long does it take to process

In public street space maximum 1 week. No statement possible on other areas, because single case test

Frequently asked Questions

• Do I remain anonymous?

Yes, only if you want to act as a witness for a report, your data will be passed on in the course of a witness statement. This requires your consent. You will then be contacted by SUBVE.

· What happens to the originator?

If a polluter is proven to have deposited the material, regulatory measures will be taken against him.

When will the wild waste disappear?

On public land within one week. For other areas, the deadlines are very different.
